## Call for applications

This Fellowship offers an opportunity to an outstanding early career scholar whose research focuses on Italy to spend a period of time at Cambridge, based at the Cambridge Centre for Research in the Arts, Social Sciences and Humanities (CRASSH). During the Fellowship, the scholar will develop their own research project, organise a one-day interdisciplinary symposium linked to a given broad theme, and interact with the Cambridge Italian Research Network (CIRN) and relevant academic departments.

The research theme for the 2026 Fellowship is 'Italian Ecologies'.

The Fellowship is open to early career scholars from outside Cambridge. **Early career** is here defined as within five years of completing a PhD in any relevant field or discipline, allowing for extensions or career breaks. Native or near-native proficiency in English is a requirement.
